## Holiday Gifting Recommendations

I know that many of our students are interested in awesome art supplies for the holidays. I like to give you a few tips, in case you're not as familiar with brands/ pricing/quality of different items. It can be easy to be tempted by large "art sets" at the holidays. These are often high priced and of very low quality. I recommend the following items, as general supply gifts that most of my students would be thrilled to receive.

- Prismacolor Color Pencils via Amazon or with a Hobby Lobby/Michaels coupon can be purchased for around \$10. (Full price is typically \$24.)
- Tombow Markers -Comparable to Copic or Prismacolor but a bit more user friendly and they don't require marker paper for mixing.
- New Hardbound Sketchbook. Amazon is a great place for hardbound sketchbooks, as well as craft stores with coupon. We use them every day in class, so hardbound is strongly preferred.
